Ordinance Committee –Alderman Jan Hall offered no report.

Police/Health, Light and Nuisance – Randy Stauffer reported that engineers are surveying Lott Blvd. and also downtown for proposed projects.

Finance Committee – Alderman Scott Davis offered no report. Chief Cushman shared the Feb. Police Report with the Council.
